The *College Outcomes Survey Graphics Report* and the *College Outcomes Summary Report* have arrived from ACT in Iowa. These two reports contain the results from the exit survey of our graduating students conducted this past Spring 2000. The graphics report provides a brief overview of the survey results with national norm comparisons, while the summary report provides frequency distributions and percentages. Outlined below is a preview highlighting some of the results.

SSCC students surveyed Spring 2000 were <u>most satisfied</u> with the following aspects of the College:

(Satisfaction Scale: 5=very satisfied, 4=satisfied, 3=neutral, 2=dissatisfied, 1=very dissatisfied)

Results of this student survey make it clear that the new library facility has had an enormously positive impact on student satisfaction. Students' satisfaction with library/learning resouce center services has gone from an average rating of 3.49 in Spring 1999 to an average rating of 4.19 in Spring 2000. This change also is reflected in the ranking order of 39 items where students were asked to rate their satisfaction. While students ranked the library number 28 out of 39 items in Spring 1999, they ranked it number one in Spring 2000. What a difference a year and a new facility can make!
