

Student Campus Enhancement Fee *Frequently Asked Questions*

Following a student-elected referendum in May 2015 to charge a student fee for facility construction and improvement, South Seattle College will begin collecting a "Student Campus Enhancement Fee" in winter 2016 to fund an initial project to build a wellness facility on the main campus.

How much is the fee?

The fee will be \$9 per credit, with a maximum of \$90 per student, charged each quarter.

Who has to pay the fee?

All students charged regular tuition will be required to pay. This includes students in academic transfer programs, professional/technical programs, distance learning, and international students.

What will the fee pay for?

The fee will fund Campus Enhancements that students have prioritized together with college leadership. The first project funded will be a wellness facility on South's main campus.

When will the facility be built?

Following a thorough architect selection process, the design of the facility began in early 2016 with construction anticipated to begin at the end of August 2020. The building is tentatively set to open at the end of August 2021.
