- Updates from Council members about the happenings within their constituent communities
  - Ben – upcoming cTc link disruptions; trainings are taking a lot of time and energy. Jamie – student ID transition update, advising live chat during system shutdown, spring schedules available on cTclink. Mahsa – busy with event planning, meetings with admin, upcoming meeting with Sen. Nguyen; used excess budget funds to supply students with supplies, cap & gown purchases. Jay – 12 person team with live chat and Zoom for cTclink transition, student loaners almost ready, establishing check-out procedures, tackling the waitlist for tech.
  - Rosie update – CARES 2.0 money priorities (one time funds, district take for IT, \$930k to direct student support, \$2.7 mil to use by 2/2022); prioritizing instruction with any remaining funds; funding categories: 1) mandatory student aid, 2) COVID response/prep, 3) instruction restoration, 4) rebuilding reserves
