The Sacrificial Poets – Jeremy Richards, Karyna McGlynn, and Gregory Hichak – are a trio of writers using language, theatre, fire, stirring audiences to laugh and think and then laugh again.

Jeremy Richards is a Seattle writer, actor, and improviser. Richards’ work has appeared on National Public Radio's *All Things Considered*. A member of two National Poetry Slam teams, Richards is the author of *Drowsy Samurai* and co-editor of the 2004 *National Poetry Slam Anthology*.

Originally from Austin, Texas, Karyna McGlynn is a poet, photographer, spoken-word artist, member of four National Poetry Slam teams and chosen for MTV’s 2004 *Rock the Vote*. Her work has recently appeared in *Midwest Quarterly*, *Cimarron Review*, *Worcester Review*, *Rosebud*, *Wisconsin Review*, *Porcupine Literary Arts Magazine*, *Good Foot Magazine* and *Verse*.

Gregory Hichak is a Seattle writer, book artist, performer, and playwright. Hichak has been published in numerous magazines and anthologies—most recently in *Zyzzyyva*, the *Bellingham Review* and in the humor collection *May Contain Nuts* (Harper/Collins).
