South Seattle Community College and Seattle University Link Programs

Students now have more options for their future thanks to a recently signed agreement between South Seattle Community College (SSCC) and Seattle University (SU).

The agreement allows conditional admission or co-enrollment to SU for SSCC students who successfully complete their Associate of Arts and certain approved Associate of Science degrees. Students need only to maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 to complete their bachelor's at SU. The agreement was signed on June 30 at a ceremony held at SU. Jill Wakefield, president of SSCC, and John D. Eshelman, SU provost, were present at the signing.

Co-enrolled SSCC students will also get help along the way. SU will host trips to its campus where there will be planned activities and programs to acquaint student with SU enrollment policies. Special orientation and advising sessions will also be held by both SSCC and SU advisors each quarter. Additionally, SU will ensure student success by assigning SU student mentors and appropriate faculty to students.

SSCC students who are interested in attending their last two years of college at SU also have the opportunity for guaranteed scholarships of \$6,000 a year. This is contingent upon graduation from SSCC with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 and maintenance of a 3.0 cumulative GPA while attending SU.

SSCC, one of the Seattle Community Colleges, is a two-year institution offering both Professional/Technical and College Transfer programs. Our 87-acre campus in West Seattle is home to 14,000 full- and part-time students. Fall quarter begins Sept. 29. For more information and a virtual campus tour, visit www.southseattle.edu.
