The South Seattle Community College Art Gallery is issuing a call for local artists to display their artwork in the “12th Annual Community Arts Exhibition.”

The show, which runs from November 15 to December 13, aims to bring together the artistic diversity of the campus and surrounding community. The show is open to artists working in all media.

To qualify for the exhibition, artists may submit a maximum of three entries of their work, which will be reviewed for selection. Entries may be in slide, print or digital format, not more than 10 MB per image. Work must be original and completed within the last two years. The deadline for submissions is Wednesday, September 20. All entries must be mailed. Include sufficient postage for the return of entry materials. All applicants will be notified by mail or phone. Selected work must be ready for installation. Cardboard or saw-tooth hangers and weak supports are not acceptable.
