## **Judge Warren and Nobie Chan Education Center to be Dedicated**

South Seattle Community College will be dedicating its newest building on campus – the Judge Warren and Nobie Chan Education Center – on Thursday, January 10, from 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The Chan Center is a joint project between South Seattle Community College and the Seattle Chinese Garden. It is named in honor of Warren Chan who was the first Asian American judge in Washington State and his wife, Nobie Chan, a trustee and former faculty member of the Seattle Community Colleges.

The Chans were contributors to the new 4,220-square-foot education center, donating \$100,000.

The building will contain two classrooms, a laboratory and an office area. It will jointly serve South's Landscape Horticulture program and the new Seattle Chinese Garden that is jointly under construction at the northeast corner of the campus.
