South Welcomes South Korea's Jeonnam Provincial College *Officials sign Memorandum of Understanding forming educational partnership.*

(Seattle, WA) Jeonnam Provincial College (JPC) in South Korea and South Seattle Community College have developed an innovative partnership to support curricular, faculty and student exchange in academic and technical education. The partnership was formalized in a Memorandum of Understanding signed by South President Gary Oertli and JPC President Dr. Choong - Gon Goo Tuesday, July 26, at a ceremony held at South.

South will offer short customized programs to JPC students, with an emphasis on English language training. Future programs exchanges in Nursing, Culinary, and Hospitality Management will also be explored. JPC offers 20 areas of study with an emphasis on technical programs. The college, established 13 years ago, enrolls over 2000 students. It is comparable to Washington state's community college system and offers both two- and three-year programs.
