This class covers everything from drinks, main dishes, desserts, and ideas for beautiful food presentations. Class is on Tuesday, July 13 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The cost is \$45.

Learn the Thrill of the Grill: This class will help you learn the differences between grilling methods: gas, wood, and charcoal. Learn tips and tricks for grilling vegetables, seafood, poultry, and beef with spices ranging from rubs to marinades. Also, learn when to use direct heat and indirect heat. There will be hands-on demonstrations and tastings throughout the class. Class is on Wednesday, July 14 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The cost is \$54.

Fun & Easy Bartending – Mixed Drinks: Learn how to measure, mix and create over 100 of today's most popular mixed drinks! For the professional bartender or the home entertainer, this class is for you! Learn free pouring and other common bartending terms, such as screaming, electric, against the wall, straight up, on the rocks, blended, and more. Also, gain an introduction to popular wines and microbeers. Alcoholic and nonalcoholic recipes are taught. This two-session course will begin on Wednesday, July 14 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The cost is \$109.
