### **South Seattle Community College and DeVry University Link Programs**

Students now have more options for their future thanks to a recently signed agreement between South Seattle Community College (SSCC) and DeVry University, Federal Way.

The agreement, which is the first of its kind between DeVry and a Washington State community college, was signed on October 15 at a ceremony held at SSCC. Jill Wakefield, interim president of SSCC, and Reed Hackett, president of DeVry University, Federal Way, signed the formal agreement.

The agreement allows technical education students from SSCC to transfer directly into several Bachelor of Science in Technical Management programs at DeVry, giving students another avenue to continue their education.

Bachelor's degrees will be offered by DeVry in the following areas: Business Administration, Computer Engineering Technology, Computer Information Systems, Electronics Engineering Technology, and Telecommunications Management.

Technical students receiving an Associate of Applied Science from SSCC in the following programs are eligible for the transfer program: Software Engineering/Programming, Web Design and Development, Network Administration, Computer Applications/Help Desk, Engineering Technology, Computer-Aided Drafting and Design Technology, Aviation Maintenance Technology, Accounting, Business Information Technology, Supervision and Management, Automotive Technology, Automotive Collision Repair.

SSCC, one of the Seattle Community Colleges, is a two-year institution offering both Professional/Technical and College Transfer programs. Our 87-acre campus in West Seattle is home to 14,000 full- and part-time students. Winter quarter begins Jan. 6.
