## **South Seattle Community College Recognizes Outstanding Faculty**

South Seattle Community College (SSCC) is pleased to announce its recipients of the third annual Seattle Community Colleges' distinguished teaching awards.

Don Howard, counselor, and Pamela Wilkins, librarian and instructor, were awarded the Dan Evans Chair for Exceptional Faculty, each receiving a \$3,000 award. Sabra Schneider, Web design and development instructor, was awarded the Dan Evans Innovation Award, receiving a \$1,500 prize. Randy Nelson, librarian and photography instructor, Esther Sunde, librarian, and Carol Koepke, computing technology instructor, were awarded the Charles Kane Award for Innovation, receiving \$2,000 for a group project to supply computing technology students with online texts.

These prestigious awards are named for Governor Daniel J. Evans, who championed and signed into law the Community College Act of 1967 and Dr. Charles Kane, the former Seattle Community Colleges chancellor who led the district from 1992 to 1998. The awards recognize outstanding work by faculty and are made possible by contributions from the district's three foundations and matching state funds.

A Seattle Community Colleges District-wide presentation ceremony was held at Seattle Central Community College on June 11.
