Lagarto Glass Exhibition Comes to South Seattle Community College

The Art Gallery at South Seattle Community College (SSCC) presents a glass show, Jan. 8 – Feb. 7, featuring the work of Lagarto Glass Blowing Studio in West Seattle.

The exhibit will consist of various pieces of hand-blown glasswork including designs made by South Seattle Community College students in the Continuing Education glass blowing class.

Lagarto Glass is the result of a vision to build a creative workshop where the needs and dreams of the customer can meet the talents and skills of the artisan. Founders Christopher Martinez and Matthew Hooks use a variety of glass blowing techniques in their hotshop including kiln casting patte-de-verre, ladling molten glass into molds, using sand to etch and carve, sculpting solid and blown glass on the pipe and lampworking.
