Mosaic Garden Art Workshop Comes to South Seattle Community College Garden Center

Are you a green thumb with a fertile imagination? The Garden Center at South Seattle Community College (SSCC) has a fall seminar that might satisfy your creative instincts.

On October 20, the SSCC Garden Center's Mosaic Garden Art Workshop will teach interested parties the ins and outs of how to make beautiful mosaic wall plaques or stepping stones. Materials used include bits and pieces of colorful tumbled glass, hand-painted ceramics, polished granite chunks, found objects, stone mix and a reusable stone mold.

Participants should bring broken china, pottery, beads, old hardware and other knickknacks, a bucket, rubber gloves, a 14" x 14" rigid board and a snack. Additional mosaic materials will be available for purchase for future projects.

Sarah Donnelly, a Seattle craftsperson and author, who designs and teaches with humor and enthusiasm, will present the workshop. She exhibits her mosaic work in retail galleries and art exhibits in the Pacific Northwest.

The seminar has an enrollment maximum of 15 people, so be sure to pre-register at (206) 634-2566.
