The following are guidelines for entrants:

- Performance and written entries may be edited for length if time constraints require it.
- Art, performances, or music may be submitted on slides, tapes, through audition request, or in person.
- The program will be coordinated by faculty in the visual, literary, and performing arts.

Deadline for submissions is April 30. Entries will be selected and participants will be notified by May 10.
