South Seattle Community College Garden Center Presents “Baffled by Weevils” Workshop

Are your plants being plagued by those pesky weevils? If so, then now is the time to gain the knowledge to help yourself and others to “fear no weevil.”

The South Seattle Community College (SSCC) Garden Center is offering the “Baffled by Weevils?” workshop on Jan. 25 from 10:00 a.m. to noon. Pre-registration is required for this \$25 workshop. All you need to do is call the SSCC Garden Center at (206) 764-5323.

Workshop participants will learn to recognize the many weevils, their life cycles, management options and timing. Participants are also encouraged to bring sample of weevils plaguing their plants – frozen then air dried and protected with tissue – for a free weevil identification and analysis

The workshop will be lead by Sharon Collman, a former WSU Cooperative Extension agent and specialist. Currently she is pursuing root weevils and a doctorate at the University of Washington College of Forest Resources – Center for Urban Horticulture, as well as being an Integrated Pest Management Outreach Coordinator, as a contractor, at the Environmental Protection Agency.
