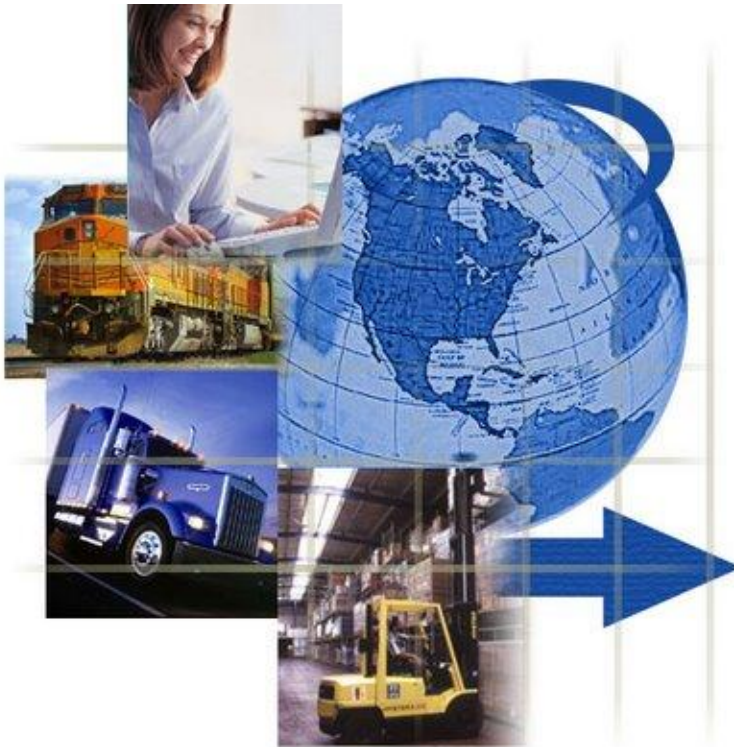

WHAT IS LOGISTICS AND SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT?

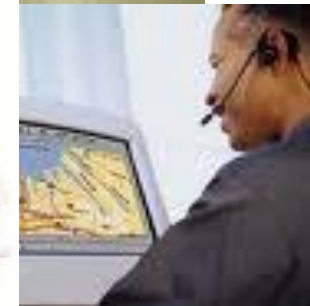


- Movement of goods and services from one place to another.

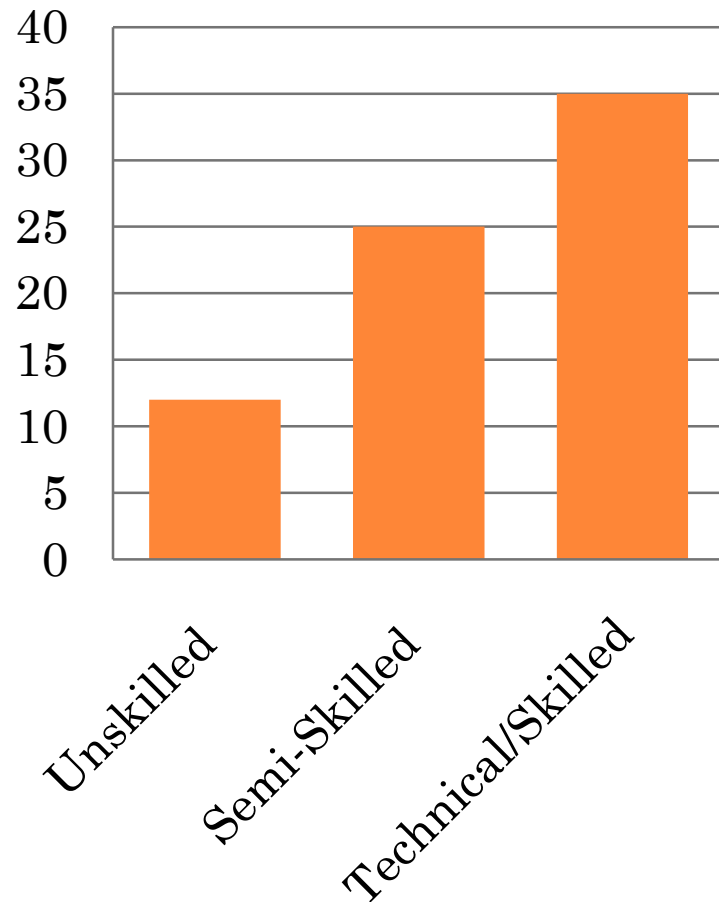
