



# HOW DO YOU APPLY FOR RUNNING START?

- Contact the Running Start Office at the college of your choice for Running Start Program information.
- Arrange with one of the Seattle Community Colleges to take the assessment test.  
*(The test is offered regularly. Students must present photo ID and pay the placement test fee)*

- Obtain your test results from the testing center. Contact the Running Start Office for the next steps.
- Consult your parents/guardians, high school counselor and teachers about your readiness for college-level work and the college environment.
- Meet with the college Running Start Coordinator / Advisor after testing for course/program eligibility.
- Return with your test scores to your high school counselor and fill out the Running Start application packet.
- Since registration is first-come first-served, it is a good idea to have an alternate course schedule should your first choice of classes be filled.
- Submit all of your Running Start application materials to the college Running Start Office. Running Start application materials include the college application form, pre-enrollment form, test scores and Running Start contract. **Running Start applications may not be submitted online.**
- Meet with the college Running Start coordinator/advisor.
- A one-time I.D. card fee (\$5.00) should be paid at time of registration. Textbooks should be purchased prior to the first day of classes and are the responsibility of the student.
- Students must pay for mandatory college fees and course fees after registering for classes. Students qualifying for free or reduced lunch may have fees waived. For more information, contact the Running Start office.
