* Chemistry: For Seattle University, applicants must complete CHEM& 121 with a C grade or better or one year of high school chemistry (with a B grade or better) within the last five years. Math and Science coursework must fall within the five-year limitation.

**Special Requirements include a 5 credit Lab Science course, a 5 credits Communication course, 8 credits of Integrated Studies, a 5 credit Global Studies Course, and a 5 credit US Cultures Course. See an advisor for more information.
