Procedures when arriving at Seattle-Tacoma International Airport

Airport Arrival

Upon arrival to Seattle, students can choose 4 transportation options when traveling from SEATAC (Seattle Tacoma Airport) airport to South Seattle.

Option 1:

Airport Pick-up from South Seattle Community College

Option 2:

Shuttle Express, Telephone 425-981-7000

- Cost approximately \$28
- Follow the signs to GROUND TRANSPORTATION, 3rd Floor of the parking garage
- Hours: 7:00 a.m.-2:00 a.m.
 - If you arrive between 2:00a.m. -7:00 a.m., please use the courtesy phone at the Shuttle Express booth and a reservation assistant will help you.
- Visa, MasterCard or Cash OK

Option 3:

Taxi

- Walk outside the Baggage Claim area to use Taxi service. From SEATAC Airport to South Seattle Community College (SSCC), the fee is between \$30-\$35

Option 4:

Public Bus

- Metro provides daily public bus service between SEATAC and South Seattle Community College (SSCC). The bus stop is outside Baggage Claim Carrousel #1. Bus route 560 and 135 run every 30 minutes and cost \$1.50. To get to SSCC, take bus 560 to White Center. Transfer to Bus 135 towards downtown.
