When students enroll at South Seattle Community College (SSCC) and Career Link Academy (CLA) they assume the obligation to observe standards of conduct which are appropriate to the pursuit of educational goals. Respect

This is my workplace and that of my fellow students. I will conduct myself so as to allow others to work comfortably and without interference.

I understand that others are different, and I will treat them kindly no matter how they look, what they can do, what they believe, or where they are from.

I will show respect for others by making verbally and physically safe and appropriate problem-solving choices.

I will be a responsible member of my family, school, and community by being accountable for my words, actions, and attitudes.

I will be a trustworthy person. I will do my own work, accept the results of my efforts, and tell the truth.

I will not have conversations that glorify violence, are of a sexually harassing nature or discriminate against others in any way.

I have the right and responsibility to say "I don't know," "I don't agree," and "I don't understand," in a calm and polite manner.

Drugs and Alcohol

I will follow the student conduct rules as put forth in the SSCC Student Handbook and the CLA policy.

I will not have conversations about or make references to the use of drugs or alcohol.

Behavior

I will follow the SSCC campus guidelines for food and drinks in the labs and classrooms, the media policy for computer use, and the smoking policy.

I will refrain from spitting, inappropriate language, loudness, or disruptive behavior.

I will be prepared to remove anything from my head (hats, head phones) per my instructor's direction. Bandanas are not allowed.

I will refrain from using my cell phone and pagers during class time.

I understand that good things can come from following our Codes of Conduct, however, there will also be negative consequences when I choose not to follow them. Failure to comply with this code of conduct may result in being sent home for the day and will result in disciplinary measures.
